MISSION 25 EXISTS TO BRING EDUCATION, COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT, DISCIPLESHIP, CLEAN WATER AND HUMAN TRAFFICKING PREVENTION TO THE 25 PROVINCES OF CAMBODIA.

WE ACCOMPLISH THIS GOAL THROUGH PARTNERSHIP WITH THE LOCAL CHURCH IN BOTH THE UNITED STATES AND CAMBODIA.

- Education: One of Mission 25's primary focuses is education because education creates change! In addition to the school M25 built and operates, we also support curriculum, technology, uniforms, and outreaches to exsisting schools. M25 has also provided scholarships and has funded educational programs.
- Clean Water: 1 in 5 children die from preventable disease due to dirty water. Mission 25 addresses this need with fresh water wells, water filters and outreaches that promote hygiene.
- Dormitories: A Mission 25 dormitory project focuses on providing a safe and healthy living environment for University students coming from the rural provinces. These high risk young people are given a place to live and a community to thrive in!
- Church Partnership: We believe that Jesus brings a hope that nothing else can. We make it a priority to partner and promote local churches. The leaders of local churches are then able to point us to what truly needs to be done to help their communites.













DIGNITY

God loves all of humanity and each of us have intrinsic value to Him. Mission 25 desires for all of Cambodia to hear and know this indisputable fact. All of our work includes teachings on dignity, value, and protecting yourself and your family from human trafficking. We partner with local organizations to prevent trafficking and to connect those in need of services.

Mission 25 is in need of financial and prayer support to continue the work being done in Cambodia. In order to do this we depend on church, corporate, and individual giving. We all have limited individual resources, but each of us has a sphere of influence. You can become a part of the work in Cambodia when you share with your personal sphere about Mission 25.



ADVOCATE

A couple believed in the work of Mission 25 from the very beginning. They invited us to their church to share about our work in Cambodia. That Church made several small donations to Mission 25 and two years later they were able to give a large grant allowing us to run the dormitory program for a full year! Following that, this church became a monthly, valued supporter of Mission25. This couple's faithfulness led to financial support that they would not have been able to provide on their own!

PLAN & PARTY

One Mission 25 advocate held a birthday party. Instead of asking friends to bring gifts, she asked them to donate toward a fresh water well in Cambodia. Amazingly her friends helped her raise enough money to dig THREE wells and purchase 39 water filters for provincial pastors!

Another advocate worked together with her family to raise funds for a water well (they have dug 3 to date!) and they sponsored the school curriculum for the Mission 25 school!

A local homeschooling group holds a fundraiser 4 times a year. They serve pizza, baked goods, and sell Mission 25 items. To date they have raised almost 6 months of a teachers salary!

WHAT THINGS COST



\$2,400:

A fresh water well for an entire village only costs \$2,400. These wells are maintained by local pastors and leaders who notify M25 of maintenance needs.

\$750:

This is what it costs for our school to run every month. The funds are dispersed as follows: \$600 for 2 teachers salaries, \$70 for snacks, and electricity, \$80 for an assistant and nanny for the teacher.

\$750:

This is the monthly cost to rent our dorms. We have a dorm for men and a seperate dorm for women. These dorms allow the students to have a safe environment to live where they are introduced to Jesus.

\$25|\$45|\$250|\$500:

These are the costs of water filters, audio bibles, baptisms, and conferences respectively. We utilize these things to reach out to local leaders and pastors in Cambodia, equipping them to continue to share the love of Christ and create diciples.
